Beginnings

ACFID has discussions with a group of Melbourne-based academics about linking universities and the sector.

The first joint ACFID and University meeting was held to discuss forming a Network, and an email group list was subsequently formed

The Network gained its own permanent page on the ACFID website and a steering group for the Network was formalised. Research papers were commissioned.

Re-branded the **ACFID University Network**, received funding from DFAT for a 3 year program. A secretariat staff member hired. Governed as an ACFID Sub-committee. Third Network Conference at ANU.

2012

April 2014, the Network started a LinkedIn group with an initial 23 members invited to join

Re-branded as the Research for **Development Impact** Network (or RDI Network), with its own brand identity. A Network Twitter account was started

July 2018: Over 1,700 network participants, 17 ACFID affiliate universities. Planning for the next phase 2018 - 21 and the seventh conference in 2019.
